

SKOKIE CONSOLIDATED DRAINAGE DISTRICT
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD
July 8, 2026

1. A Regular Meeting of Skokie Consolidated Drainage District was called to order at 6:30 p.m. at the Deerfield Village Hall, 850 Waukegan Road, Deerfield, IL 60015. Those in attendance included Commissioners Todd Needlman, Mary Scanlan Hogan, Janice Aull, Project Coordinator Patricia Werner, and Attorney Bryan R. Winter. Notice of the meeting was completed by posting requisite notices, in accordance with the requirements of the Open Meetings Act.
2. There was no Public Comment.
3. On motion duly made, seconded and by roll call vote, all Commissioners voted in favor of the motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held on June 10, 2026.
4. The Commissioners reviewed the status of accounts which indicated a balance on hand as of June 30, 2026 in the amount of \$373,594.88 for Subdistrict No. 1-East Skokie and a balance on hand as of June 30, 2026 in the amount of \$320,165.61 for Subdistrict No. 2-West Skokie.
5. On motion duly made, seconded and by roll call vote, all Commissioners voted in favor of the motion to approve the payment of the following bills for services to Subdistrict No. 1-East Skokie:

7. The Commissioners received a report from Patricia Werner, Project Coordinator, who reported the following:
- A. **Highland Park Project Phase 3 (Subdistrict No. 1-East Skokie):** The north and south streambank sections are completed. The middle section near the staging area will be completed as the last stage of the project to maintain equipment ingress/egress. Tree and shrub plantings occurred in early June on the east side of the channel. The Old Elm golf course has agreed to water the newly planted landscaping located on the east side of the project. The placement of landscaping for the west bank side of the project will be scheduled later this year after the staging area is restored.
 - B. **Atkinson Road Reservoir (Subdistrict No. 2-West Skokie):** The District received a June inspection report for the Reservoir from Gewalt Hamilton and Associates (GHA). The report indicated that the pumps and inlets are in good condition and are working properly. The sump pump recorded 16.4 hours of run time on June 24, 2026 in response to a significant rain event. Forest Builders Inc. (FBI) has continued to remove woody brush and apply herbicide around the perimeter of the basin and spoil hill to maintain vegetation at the site.
 - D. **Channel Maintenance (Subdistrict No. 1-East Skokie):** Forest Builders Inc. has performed vegetation maintenance work at the past project sites located at P&G, Foss Golf Course, ComEd and the Chalet. Also, Dunlap Tree Services recently cleared channel blockages at the Deerpath Golf Course and will remove dead standing trees at other Lake Forest channel locations.
 - E. **Channel Maintenance (Subdistrict No. 2-West Skokie):** The Project Coordinator will be meeting with Forest Builders Inc. to review completed vegetation maintenance work and consider future management plans.
 - F. **NPDES Permit – MS4 Program:** Gewalt Hamilton has begun coordinating inspections for the 2026 NPDES Permit report that will need to be filed next spring.

8. On motion duly made, seconded and by roll call vote, all Commissioners voted to approve Ordinance 26-01 to authorize the execution of Petition for Court Order to Abate Interest and Penalty Amounts Related to Unpaid Assessments for Properties Located at 13735 W. Atkinson Rd. and 0 Atkinson Rd., Green Oaks, Illinois 60048.
9. On motion duly made, seconded, and carried, the meeting was adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
